Report: Flextronics to Cut 1,100 Employees in Hungary

ZALAEGERSZEG, HUNGARY – **Flextronics** plans to lay off 1,100 employees from its plants here, according to published reports.

A local labor official said the contract assembly indicated it intends to fire 950 blue-collar and 150 white-collar employees, mostly in December. The cuts will lower the EMS provider's Hungary headcount to a reported 2,000.

The firm already laid off some 500 workers in Hungary this year after **RIM** cut its smartphone orders.
