**WUXI CITY, CHINA --** Jabil reportedly will invest RMB 620 million (\$100 million) to build a robot-driven automation equipment plant in Wuxi City, in cooperation with the local government, according to local reports.

Jabil currently operates three units in Wuxi City, including **Green Point Technology (Wuxi)**Co., and employs a reported 60,000 workers. It generated a reported RMB 15 billion (\$2.4 billion) in sales from the Wuxi sites last year from customers such as Apple, Sony Ericsson, Motorola and Nokia.

Jabil expects to generate \$80 million a year from the new plant, the reports said.
